Livestock Project News

Beef Project Tagging - March 30 @ MN CO Fairgrounds 8-9 AM

Please note: this is the <u>only</u> county wide tagging date for the beef cattle project. Cattle that need tagged are Market projects and Commercial Breeding Heifers. If you are unable to participate on the 30th please notify the Extension Office, so that your cattle can be properly identified with a Kansas 4-H tag. All tagging and documentation needs to be completed by Monday, April 7, 2025.

Bucket Calf Project News

The Marion County Bucket Calf Project has gone through some updates:

NEW this year: The calf **MUST** be identified with a Marion County Bucket Calf
tag - tagging will take place during countywide small animal tagging in April

4-H members are encouraged to enter the NEW Bucket Calf Poster Class at the Marion County Fair. The posters should be:

- A standard 28" x 22" size
- Include the 4-Her's Name, Calf's Name, Breed of Calf and any information you would like to share about the calf.
- Posters will be hung above each calf in the Stall Barn
- A judge will meet with each 4-Her in a conference style judging format to discuss what the 4-Her learned and evaluate the posters.

Bucket Calf Project Members are also encouraged to participate in the Bucket Calf Costume Contest at the fair. 4-H members and their calf are dressed up and paraded around as a short script is read. 4-H members write the script describing the the costumes they have put together. If you have any questions about the Bucket Calf Project please contact the Extension office - we have received a few calls from producers who have an extra calf.

Horse Project News

The Kansas Department of Animal Health has sent out an update stating that any horse participating in a local show must have tested NEGATIVE for Coggins. The test must have been completed in the previous 12 months prior to the event. You will have to provide proof at the Marion County Horse Show from your veterinarian that your horse tested NEGATIVE for Coggins.

Please be proactive - we will try to remind you!

Small Animal Tagging: May 4 @ MN CO Fairgrounds 5-9 PM

Please note: this is a date change. Small Animal Tagging will take place at the fairgrounds in Hillsboro. This will be for bucket calves, sheep, goats, and swine. Anyone interested in their animals participating in the Rate of Gain contest will have to be in Hillsboro on May 4 as that will be the only date used for the contest. If you are unable to attend that day please notify the Extension Office. If Inclement weather: May 9th is a back up date. All Small Animals must be tagged by May 9th. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**

Rate of Gain Contest

This contest will be available for Beef, Sheep, Goats & Swine Market Projects. The dates used are March 30th for Beef Cattle & May 4th for the small animals. Weights recorded those days will be compared to the weights recorded at the county fair. The 4-Her who owns the animal who gained the most will receive a prize at the County Fair. **GOOD LUCK!**
