Fair Week Information:

Fair Set Up: Saturday, July 20, starting at 8:00 AM (until we finish). Please make plans to help! Make sure to bring some extra buckets and towels, leaf blower, brooms, rakes, and a drill if you have one!

Fair Clean Up/Project Release: Saturday, July 27th, starting at 8:00 AM static projects inside the 4-H Building will be released to go home. Livestock may be released **NO EARLIER** than 9:00 PM Friday, July 26th. IT IS EXPECTED TO COME BACK AND HELP CLEAN UP!

Exhibit Check-In: Tuesday, July 23rd from 5:00-8:00 PM — ALL 4-H BUILDING MUST BE AT THE FAIR (Except Horticulture, Floriculture, Crops with a check in time of 7:30 AM on Wednesday, July 24th). Static check-in will be in the 4-H Building. After checking in, you will make sure all labels/entry cards are attached to your exhibit, Member has signed up for a judging time, and the exhibit has been taken to the appropriate location in the building. Labels are available in the extension office and will be available in the 4-H Building the day of check in. Anyone can enter the 4-Her's project for them.

Livestock Check-In: All Livestock MUST BE IN PLACE by Tuesday, July 23rd at 8:00 PM. Livestock check-in will take place on Wednesday, July 24th. Beginning at 8:30 AM, Livestock Exhibitors need to pick up Fair Entry Cards for each animal from the scales. Corrections need to be written on said card before check-in. The check-in order will be as followed beginning at 9:00 AM: Swine, Beef, Sheep, Meat Goats, Rabbits, and Poultry.

Livestock Show Schedule:

Thursday 9:00 AM: Dairy Goat followed by Dairy Cattle

Thursday 4:00 PM: Rabbits and Poultry

Thursday 6:00 PM: Sheep followed by Bucket Calf then Beef

Friday 9:00 AM: Swine followed by Meat Goats

*Intent to Sell Deadline: Immediately following conclusion of Meat Goat Show

Friday 1:30 PM: Round Robin

Intent to Exhibit at State Fair: If your project qualifies for exhibition at the State Fair, you are eligible – not obligated to enter one per class at the State Fair. There will be a QR code posted at each project table that you can scan to enter information for State Fair Entries in those selected projects.

Friends of 4-H Event and Project Auction: Friday, July 26th --All 4-H'ers and families are invited to come to this event. A meal will be provided by Peabody Achievers from 5:00 – 6:30PM. Each Club is responsible for a \$200 donation for the meal. The Auction will take place in the Pavilion with Livestock. We will be inviting all who support the 4-H program throughout the year to be our guests! NOTE: As a 4-Her it is important to personally thank a buyer. Please make sure to write a thank you note after your turn in the auction.

4-H Member Volunteers Needed: Throughout the Fair we will need 4-H Members to assist with events and activities. Please make sure to sign-up your 4-Her for a time slot on Fair Entry.

Friends of 4-H Event: Friday, July 26th –Volunteer to serve meal and drinks to 4-H Families and Supporters before the 4-H Livestock and Project Auction. We will need a total of 10 youth from 4:30-6:30 PM. No age limit required.

4-H Concession Stand: This year we will have a 4-H Concession Stand that will operate Wednesday, Thursday and Friday. The Concession Stand's goal is to provide a food option for families on the fairgrounds. Talk to your club about signing up for a time to work the 4-H Concession Stand. We will need 3 youth and 1 adult for each time slot. Youth will need to be 10 years and older to assist. Please reach out to your club leader if you are able to help work the concessions.
